L ----VIA CABRILLO MARINA 0.0 0.6
R----22ND ST 0.6 0.3
L ----SIGNAL ST 0.9 1.2
Becomes SAMPSON WY

L ----6TH ST 2.1 0.1
L ----HARBOR BLVD 2.2 0.7
R----CRESCENT AV 2.9 0.5
L ----MESA ST 3.4 0.1

R----22ND ST 3.5 0.1
L ----PACIFIC AV 3.6 1.2
R----SHEPARD ST 4.8 2.1
Becomes PASEO DEL MAR

R----Cont/R --Western Ave 6.9 0.6
L ----25TH ST 7.5 1.6
R----PALOS VERDES DR EAST 9.1 1.8

Optional Climb - from Palos Verdes Dr. West

The climb adds only about 2 - 3 miles

L-- Via Montemar

R-- Via Del Monte

R-- Granvia Altamira

R-- Hawthorne

L --Palos Verdes Dr. West & back on route
(becomes Palos Verdes Dr. South etc.)

R---- PASEO DEL MAR (Note: This is the second "Paseo Del Mar" street sign.) 22.1 2.0
R----VIA ANACAPA 24.1 0.4
R----PALOS VERDES DR WEST 24.5 1.6
(becomes PALOS VERDES DR S, becomes 25TH ST.)

Caution! Sharp dips in road at Portuguese Bend.

Continue straight-ahead on SHEPARD ST.

Continue north on PACIFIC AV. 34.9 1.6

R---- 22ND ST 36.5 0.1

R----VIA CABRILLO MARINA 36.6 0.6

Finish at parking lot 37.2

Ride Description:

Start: Cabrillo Marina in San Pedro (from Pasadena, south on the I-110 to the end in San Pedro, continue straight on Gaffey, L-on 22nd St, R- Via Cabrillo Marina, R- Shoshonean Rd, immediate left into the parking lot)

37 mi. Rolling terrain with moderately steep hills. Escape the heat and enjoy the cool breeze on this tour of San Pedro and Palos Verdes. Lunch in San Pedro.
